GUIDE TO THE CHAMPIONSHIP APPEALS PROCESS

Aim

To resolve questions and claims about points recorded in the Championship Tables.

We hope these can be resolved quickly and amicably between the member, event organiser and the Championship Secretary.

Publication of Results : MSA Criteria

Year Book (Blue Book) Sect 'D' paras 26.1 to 26.3 inc

Members should be aware your results in a Cirencester Car Club event are published within the MSA Guidelines; usually on the day and then circulated quickly thereafter. Following the issuing of 'Provisional' Results they will go 'Final' seven days later.

This rule is also applied to the publication of the year end Championship results.

Our Club Championship tables will be published regularly; usually monthly and you should check to ensure your results are correct.

Eligibility

The **Appeals Process** is open to any member of Cirencester Car Club whose name appears, or should appear, in any Championship Award Table.

The process

- 1) The member endeavours to resolve their question / claim with the Championship Secretary and or relevant organiser.
- 2) If not satisfied the matter is referred to the Appeals Panel for adjudication.
- 3) The Appeals Panel will consist of three Senior and experienced Members of Cirencester Car Club. They may refer to any information available including the relevant Club 'Guide' and the MSA criteria.
- 4) The Panel decides the issue by simple majority vote and records its decision in writing to the claimant.
- 5) The decision of the Appeals Panel is final.

Independence of View

To ensure impartiality, it is agreed, that whilst the Championship Secretary and members of the Appeals Panel may enter into any Cirencester Car Club event through out the year and have their results recorded in the relevant Championship Table(s) to evidence their Motor Sport activity, they will not be eligible for Year end award(s) and will have their results discounted or removed from the final Championship outcomes.
