The Chairman's aims for the Club over the next year will include to increase in 12 Car Rally entries, together with increasing support for the Winter and Summer Series.

He had asked Ben and Mark to set up a Meeting to review the Rules and report back to the Committee.

As there was still an outstanding vacancy for **Competitions Secretary** it was felt the organisers running specific events should complete the application for the MSA Permit.

This would give the Club a large pool of 'event' expertise.

The vacant post of Competitions Secretary was dropped and an "**Idiots Guide**" will be prepared as a reference point for event organisers.

Action point: Sub committee / steering group to look at Rules.

The Club Guide is out of date and this is a project to be undertaken this year.

New venues for the Club Meetings are being investigated as the 2009/2010 Committee had felt we had out stayed our welcome at the Highway Inn.

There is a new job title for this coming year of Social Secretary. A recent 'Grub Nite' gathering at the Five Mile House proved very successful with 18 members attending. It is hoped more of these events will take place.
